



## Access to Higher Education Diploma in Art and Design

### Additional Course Costs

<p>Equipment/materials needed</p>	<p>The course will pay for, or subsidise, most of the essential materials used during studio activities such as drawing and in practical workshops.</p> <p>There will however be some costs incurred during your course: for example, you will need to purchase a specialist equipment pack for £110 from UCA's online store.</p>
<p>Equipment/materials recommended</p>	<p>As you progress through your course you may require further specialist materials and equipment which will vary depending on the nature of your work.</p> <p>There is a very competitively priced shop on campus where you can purchase additional notebooks, art materials, mounting materials, papers, etc. Photocopying and professional quality digital printing (A4 up to large format A0+ sizes) is available through our print bureau at much reduced prices from those available commercially.</p>
<p>Visits</p>	<p>Each year there are a number of course trips to museums, galleries and locations that play a part in your study and serve to inform and enrich your studio work and portfolio. The range of trips vary according to availability of venue and entry fees. If you want to go on the trips there are two options.</p> <p>The two options you have are:</p> <p>Option 1 - £470 This includes a UK Day Trip (approximately £70) &amp; a residential 5-6 day trip to Amsterdam (approximately £400)</p> <p>Option 2 - £140 This includes a UK Day Trip (approximately £70) &amp; a UK alternative to the Amsterdam trip (approximately £70)</p> <p><i>Please note that whilst we will do our best to organise these trips, they will be dependent on COVID-19 Guidelines.</i></p>
