<p>Equipment/materials needed</p>	<p>These items are things which you may need, depending on your approach to work and on the projects. Select some to purchase initially, and build up as and when you need them: On your first day please come equipped with the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- General drawing and painting materials / cartridge paper / sketchbook*</li> <li>- Craft Knife or Scalpel</li> <li>- Masking and Gaffer tape,</li> <li>- Retractable metal tape measure</li> <li>- Scissors.</li> <li>- An academic diary / notebook</li> <li>- An A4 ring file for technical notes</li> <li>- Two passport-sized photographs of yourself</li> <li>- Enclosed and fairly sturdy shoes.
