<p>Equipment/materials needed</p>	<p>There are costs attached to some processes such as digital and screen printing. A payment system is in place and will be explained within the induction week.</p>
<p>Equipment/materials recommended</p>	<p>The items listed below are considered necessary. This is by no means a complete list – in time, depending on your own interests and direction of study you may require other more specific equipment. Please don't worry about buying anything yet as we will brief you on arrival.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A broad selection of drawing materials, e.g. pens, pencils - A5 note book, e.g. Moleskine - Clean new memory stick, e.g. 4GB - 300mm steel ruler <p>NB: The London Graphic Centre is a well trusted supplier</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Apple Mac laptop with Adobe Creative Suite. The Graphic Communication course has good access to Apple Mac desktop computers but a laptop is essential to enable you to continue to work outside of the IT suites. PC laptops are also useful of course, but the campus is Apple Mac orientated. It will prove beneficial to your studies if you own your own Mac (or PC). <p>It is recommended that you wait until you are enrolled on the Graphic Communication course before purchasing an Apple Mac in order to qualify for educational discount.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Cameras are useful for image generation and visual research. Don't spend huge sums of money though; I'm a big believer in the usefulness of phone cameras. 35mm models are great but good digital cameras are more instantly functional, particularly for research. - A3 (or A2) pad of 'layout' paper - A good selection of pencils - Rubber and putty rubber - Pencil sharpener - Selection of black felt tips (up to very thick) - A3 cutting mat - Scalpel and packet of blades - Pair of scissors - Pritt stick
