

## Additional Course Costs

<p><b>BA (Hons) Fine Art (Full-time/Part-time/4-year) Canterbury</b></p>	
<p>Equipment/materials needed</p>	<p>In addition to basic art equipment like sketchbooks and a portfolio we suggest that all students have the following as a minimum:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Drawing materials (pencils, charcoal, ink, brush pens, masking tape, putty rubber etc...)</li> <li>- Acrylic Paint Set and a range of brushes (flat and round)</li> <li>- Scissors, Craft Knife</li> <li>- Basic Hand Tools (Pliers, screwdrivers, claw hammer, small handsaw etc.)</li> <li>- A spirit level</li> </ul>
<p>Equipment/materials recommended</p>	<p>In addition to the above we recommend that all students also have the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- An electric drill / screwdriver</li> <li>- Digital camera</li> <li>- USB Storage device</li> </ul>
<p>Visits</p>	<p>During Induction Week we expect to make a trip to a regional Art gallery such as the Turner Contemporary, in Margate, by train. You will need to budget for the cost of off-peak train fare.</p> <p>Throughout the course various study trips and gallery visits are scheduled, destinations and prices vary but you will have to pay your own travel costs to participate. Please note these are not mandatory and alternative arrangements are made to make sure your studies are not impacted if you elect not to attend a trip or study visit. In recent years we have organized international study trips to New York, Venice, Berlin and Copenhagen.</p>
