

## Additional Course Costs

Equipment/materials needed	<p>Most students own their own laptop computer – although this is not essential (we are well equipped with computer suites with the latest software). The major financial outlay will be for printing and mounting your work for the postgraduate show, which will vary from student to student depending on the nature of your submission.</p> <p>The course will pay for materials used during inductions, (specifically during printmaking inductions). Some materials, such as basic paper and inks will be provided free of charge. Once printmaking inductions are completed you will have to pay for printmaking materials such as screens, plates, paper, etc. Any specialist materials required, for example, inks, liquid watercolours and fine art inkjet paper, are purchased by students as they need them.</p>
Visits	<p>There will be some costs incurred during the course, for instance for visits to galleries and exhibitions. Field trips inside the UK are sometimes free, but you are likely to be expected to cover associated travel costs, such as for travelling to London for an exhibition for example or going on location to draw.</p> <p>For the past few years, students have visited the OFFF conference in Barcelona. The trip is not compulsory but if you would like to participate you should budget approximately £500 for the cost for tickets, accommodation, food and travel. Many students also take the opportunity to travel around Europe whilst on the course.</p>
