Equipment/materials needed	<p>You will need the following everyday materials many of which are available from the University shop. <b>When we get closer to the subject specialist units we will advise you on the tools/materials that you're likely to need.</b></p> <p>Over the course of study you will require the following -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- A1 portfolio</li> <li>- A piece of non-absorbent board or Perspex for mixing paint             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Acrylic paint set</li> <li>- Oil Paint set</li> </ul> </li> <li>- Range of brushes (flat and round)</li> <li>- Thick and thin charcoal (willow sticks) and compressed charcoal</li> <li>- Sketchbooks (2 to 3 in range of sizes, qualities of paper)</li> <li>- Notebook</li> <li>- Putty rubber</li> <li>- Pencils</li> <li>- Masking Tape</li> <li>- Scissors</li> <li>- Hammer</li> <li>- Screwdrivers (1 flat and 1 cross-head -medium)</li> <li>- Screws, nails, pack of bulldog clips</li> <li>- Pliers</li> <li>- Medium Bottle of Indian Ink</li> <li>- USB Storage device</li> <li>- Set of Graphic pens (various colours)</li> </ul>
Equipment/materials recommended	<p><b>Equipment is provided so you don't need to acquire your own but if you want to you would benefit from having the following. Visits	<p>During Induction Week we expect to make a London by train. These overseas trips are not compulsory but we hope all students will participate; costs range from £200 – £350 depending on mode of travel and accommodation.
