

Kent 16+ Travel Card

An annual bus pass available from 1st September 2015 until 31st August 2016 giving unlimited bus travel throughout Kent. Students must be a resident of Kent (live in a house that pays Council tax to a Kent district council for Kent County Council Services). The standard full year cost of the pass is £400. If you live in the Medway district you will not be eligible for this pass. Further information is available at

Medway Council Subsidised Travel Pass

An annual travel pass providing home to college travel during the academic year only. Students must be resident in Medway (live in a house that pays Council Tax to Medway Council). The cost of the bus pass for 2015/16 is £688 a year or £229 a term. Train passes are also available which give a 34% reduction on the standard adult fare. Prices will be available from Medway Council Student Services Operations Team by telephoning 01634 331155.

Medway Council Youth Pass

A bus pass enabling students to pay half the adult fare on all journeys where bus companies would normally charge young people the adult fare. There is a one-off £10.00 charge, and the pass is valid up to the end of the academic year after your 18th birthday.

- Note : A minimum fare of £12 applies when travelling before 10am, Monday – Friday, Sept - June
