BA (Hons) Fashion Design (4 year) Rochester	
Equipment/ materials needed	<p>It is essential for students on BA (Hons) Fashion Design (4 year) to bring with them the following equipment when they join the course in September:</p> <p>These items are available from Staples, WH Smith, UCA Shops and various other stationery shops:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Small Perspex Ruler- H + B Pencils (HB, 2H etc)- Set of Coloured Fine Liner Pens- Scotch Tape (Magic Tape)- Pencil Sharpener + Eraser- Thimble (get size to fit middle finger)- Digital Camera – for recording processes, demo’s etc. <p>These are some other costs that students will need to consider whilst studying.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Previously, students contributed approximately £200 towards the cost of the end of year photo shoots and shows in year 3.- Sketchbooks and general art equipment are part of every project. Projects often involve the use of fabrics, which can be bought from the on site shop although the majority are sourced from other suppliers.- Students can produce digitally printed fabrics on site. The base cloth can also be bought on site.- An A3/A4 portfolio case.
Visits	Trips to London are an important part of the course and students are expected to make several visits during projects to visit exhibitions, undertake Fashion Trails and source fabric and trims;

	<p>you will be expected to cover the travel costs of such visits. Overseas trips to Paris and New York are also available (they are not compulsory) and cost around £200 for Paris and £800 for New York depending on numbers and dates of travel.</p>
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Students also have the chance to show at Graduate Fashion Week in London in year 3.
