Application Form Declaration

By submitting an application to UCA, we will consider that you have read this declaration and agree to its contents.

Information in your application

You must provide accurate information in your application and should contact us if the information changes. It is important to let us know if your email address, telephone number or address changes to ensure we can contact you. If we believe that information in your application is incorrect, false, or is missing, we may contact you, your referee or your college to check/request this.

Your personal statement must have been written by yourself and any portfolio work you provide must be your own work. If we discover that your application or portfolio includes false, fraudulent or plagiarised information, we will be entitled to amend withdraw or cancel your application/offer.

How many applications you can make

You may apply to more than one course at UCA. If you are interested in a pre-degree course offered at multiple campuses, you should make one application to your preferred campus; you can change your campus at a later date.

You can only accept one course at UCA. If you accept multiple offers, we will contact you to arrange for additional applications to be withdrawn.

If we make a mistake

Your contract with UCA
